Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- To show sensitivity to others' needs and feelings.
- To try new activities.

Communication, Language and Literacy

- To speak confidently and clearly thinking about the listener.
- To use a range of strategies to read words and phrases independently.
- To use capital letters and full stops in our sentences.
- To write poems, facts and recounts.

Numeracy and Shape, space and measure

- To double and halve numbers 1-20.
- To develop language for money.
- To understand number bonds to 5 and 10 e.g. $3+2=5$ $4+1=5$
- To continue to practise adding and subtracting two single-digit numbers.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

- To find out facts about their class minibeast.
- To learn about the different creatures that live in gardens.
- To look at similarities and differences in the environment.

Creative Development

- To use the paper and paste lamination technique to create our own minibeasts.
- To use our imagination and language to recreate a role during drama work.
- To follow visual symbols that tell us how or when to sing or play instruments.

Physical Development

- To develop bat and ball skills.
- To work as a team.
