Draw your own map of an imaginary land. Label the different areas on it.



Design and make your own Beast. It could be based on one from a story or from your own imagination. You could draw it or make a model of it using junk or craft materials.



Listen to Stravinsky's Firebird. While you are listening, draw what it makes you think of. What instruments can you hear being played?



Complete an observational drawing at home. Find something interesting e.g. a toy or a piece of fruit and draw a picture of it, looking carefully at the tone and shade.



Your IMPACT work this half term is to learn and practise the times tables for x2 x5 and x10.

You need to learn each set so that you should be able to answer calculations quickly such as

$$3 \times 2 =$$

$$4 \times 5 =$$

$$10 \times 7 =$$
