English

- Writing for different audiences ensuring that we include:
 - Different sentence types
 - A range of conjunctions

 - Correct punctuation

 - Correct spellings

Maths

- Reading, writing and ordering numbers to at least 100.
- Calculation strategies using +, -, x and ÷.
- Calculating amounts of money or change using all coins.
- Using calculations for measuring and handling data.

Science

- Learning about minibeasts and their habitats.
- Learning about different animal groups and their features.
- Investigating plants as living things and the conditions they need for growth.

Computing

- Using coding to instruct the computer.
- Perfecting typing skills and mouse control.
- Data collection and presenting results.

R.E.

- Exploring what 'creation' means.
- Comparing versions of the creation story in different religions.

Music

- Exploring timbre, tempo and dynamics within musical compositions and tuned instruments.
- Developing vocal technique and performance skills.
