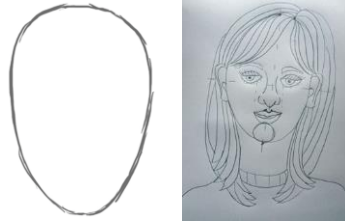


More Roald Dahl Topic Homework ideas – March 2019
