English

Maths

- Learning about capacity and volume using appropriate measurements.
- Learning about position and direction using language such as half turn, quarter turn and three quarter turn.

History

- Investigating Lord Nelson's life and visiting HMS Victory.
- Learn about other historical figures linked to our Dockyard.
- Learn about famous pirates, including Blackbeard.

Computing

- Use a programme to find pictures.
- Use a programme to create a treasure map using images.

R.E.

- Learning about people Jesus met.
- Seeing changes that Jesus made.
- Recognising changes in our own lives.

Music

- Exploring texture and rhythm.
- Learning songs linked to the topic.

Art

- Making a parrot using paper and paste lamination skills.
- Improving skills working with a partner to achieve something together.

P.E.

- Gymnastics through forming different balances.
- Travelling around, through and over equipment in imaginative ways.

Geography

- Learning about Oceans.
 - Using this information to make and labels our own maps.
- Learning about compass points and using these to explore our environment.
