### English

- Reading & spelling Common Exception Words.
- Looking at the features of superhero books and writing our own.
- Using correct punctuation in our writing.
- Using our phonic skills to sound out real and alien words.

### Maths

- Learning about addition and subtraction, using a range of equipment to solve problems.
- Recognising and continuing a repeating pattern.
- Using our mathematical understanding to problem solve.

### History

- Investigating Grace Darling's life and looking at the role of suffragettes in history.
- Learning about other heroes within our lifetime, including heroes from our community.

### Computing

- Using directions to program a toy to move along a map.
- Writing simple instructions for someone to follow.
- Making simple predictions and testing.
- Learning how to de-bug a program.

### R.E.

- Learning the Easter story and why it is important to Christians.
- Identifying and understanding different emotions within others.

### Music

- Exploring texture and rhythm.
- Learning songs linked to the topic to perform to parents.
- Learning to play the recorder.

### Art

- Learning about the Artist Paul Klee.
- Designing and making artwork in the style of Paul Klee.
- Learning about Pop Art and looking at Artists such as Roy Lichtenstein.

### P.E.

- Learning traditional Country Dancing.
- Join in with rhythmical movements.
- Learn and perform short dances with a partner and in small groups.

### Science

- Learning about everyday materials, such as metal, plastic, clay and wood.
- Thinking about why certain materials are used for certain objects.
- Investigating the best materials to use to make something waterproof.
- Working in a team to predict, investigate, question and explain.
