English

- Reading & spelling Common Exception Words.

Maths

- Investigating volume and using this to solve problems.
- Learning to find different fractions of shapes, amounts and number.

Science

- Planning and carrying out our own investigations, such as making parachutes.
- Using skills such as predicting, recording and explaining.

Computing

- Learning about Stop Frame Animation.
- Using a range of skills and technology to make our own group Stop Frame Animation movie.

R.E.

- Understanding special celebrations and festivals for different people.
- Making links between other peoples' experiences and our own.

Music

- Learning and practising a range of playground games and chants.
- Singing new and traditional songs and rhymes.

DT

- Using new and previously learnt techniques to make a picture with a sliding mechanism.
- Evaluating our work and making changes or improvements.

- Ball skills - catching, throwing, aiming.
- Learning how to control a ball accurately.
- Using these skills to play team ball games, such as Non-Stop Cricket.

- Learning about Sculpture and notable Artists, such as Antony Gormley.
- Using different media such as plasticine and clay to build sculptures.
- Planning and making backgrounds for our Stop Frame Animation movies.
