<p>When you are out and about or even just at home play a game of 'I spy' using the beginning sounds of words.</p> 	<p>Visit your local library and look for books related to our topic of 'Celebrations'. You could look at non-fiction books about the celebrations of different cultures or read the many fiction books based on the topic. Get cosy and read them in the library or get a library card for your child (if they don't have one already) and take the books home to enjoy.</p> 	<p>Get crafty and make a celebration card for someone. Encourage your child to write the inside of the card themselves, thinking about the sounds they can hear in words.</p> 
<p>Visit a Santa's Grotto or explore Portsmouth looking for Christmas lights. Talk to your child about your local area. Encourage your child to take a photograph for themselves using any technology you have.</p> 	<p>Make something you would eat during a celebration e.g. jelly, a cake, sandwiches.
